6. Bumerangas [Boomerang]

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Dialogue and Argumentation:

We can challenge ideas respectfully

Disagreement does not mean confrontation. How can we disagree respectfully? Talk about words and phrases children can use to show respect, eg. *'I can see your point, however...'* and remind them it is the idea, not the person, they are challenging.

We understand the impact of consumerism

Discussion Prompts

About the film:

Explain the idea of 'consumerism' and over-consuming

- *Why might the film be called Boomerang?*
- *What are the impacts of the people's actions?*
- *What could they do to not over-consume?*

Beyond the film:

Introduce the talking point: *'Consumers should pay a fee based on the amount of waste they produce'*

Ask groups to discuss this and feed-back, focusing on how they challenged ideas respectfully.

Ideas for Cultural Expression

Create a diorama showing the negative effects of over-consumption.
